Chairman's Report 2009/10

In 2009/10, Aberdeen University Hong Kong Association (AUHKA), in collaboration with Swire Educational Trust and British Council, continues the tradition of providing scholarship to potential leaders in environmental-related fields. This kind of partnership has been established since 1991. In the summer of 2009, Miss Carol Law was granted a full scholarship by AUHKA to pursue her master degree of Urban Planning and Real Estate in the University of Aberdeen (AU) with the "Aberdeen Scott Environmental Scholarship" under the full financial support of Swire Educational Trust. To celebrate the conferment of scholarship, the Association held a farewell dinner for the new scholar on 16th Sept 2009 at VIP Room, Hong Kong Football Club. More than 24 guests and alumni took part in this event. The first 2009/10 Committee Meeting was also held at the same place right before the commencement of the farewell dinner.
